Introduction:

The "Sahakar Se Samridhi" initiative aims to transform Primary Agriculture Credit Societies (PACS) into Multi-Service Centers (MSC) or Multi-Purpose PACS (M-PACS) to maximize profitability and enhance rural development. By diversifying their activities, PACS can engage in various business operations, including retailing petrol and diesel, distributing LPG, and operating Jan Aushadhi Kendras for generic medicines. The computerization of PACS, with an outlay of ₹2,516 crore, enhances transparency and efficiency. Additionally, PACS are being integrated as Common Service Centers (CSCs) to provide e-services, boosting their viability and generating rural employment. These strategies not only improve the economic vibrancy of PACS but also ensure better access to essential services for rural communities, thereby driving sustainable growth and prosperity.

Venue and Accommodation: The programme is residential and will be conducted at **Madurai, Tamil Nadu**. Participants will have to make their own travel arrangements. No cost in this regard will be borne by NABARD.

The nominating institutions are strictly advised not to send any such participants. Prior permission may be obtained by the participants for overstay, in case of any unforeseen circumstances or emergencies only and in such cases, additional cost, if any, may be borne by the respective participant.

Fee & Mode of Payment: The programme is sponsored by NABARD and hence **no participation fee** is collected from banks towards boarding, lodging and to impart training to the participants. However, concerned Bank may bear the to and fro travelling cost of the participants to attend the programme.

How to Reach Madurai

A. By Road

Madurai District is well connected with the National Highways NH 7, NH 45B, NH 208 and NH 49 passing through Madurai. The state highways passing through the city are SH-33, SH-72, SH-72A, SH-73 and SH-73A which connect various parts of Madurai district.

B. By Rail

Madurai Junction is the major railway station serving the District. Being the headquarters of the Madurai division of the Southern Railway, there are direct trains connecting Madurai with other major cities and towns across India including New Delhi, Mumbai, Calcutta and Chennai.

C. By Air

Madurai Airport was established in 1957 and is located at Avaniyapuram, about 12 kilometres (7.5 mi) from the city. It offers domestic flights to some cities in India. The airport was declared a customs airport in 2012 allowing limited number of international flights and international services to Colombo, Dubai and Singapore. The carriers operating from the airport are Air India, Air India Express, Jet Airways, SpiceJet, Indigo and Srilankan Airlines.
