On-Location Training Programme on Agri Value Chain Financing and Climate Resilience (21 to 23 July 2025)

Introduction:

Agricultural Value Chain Mapping encompasses identifying key stakeholders, processes, and bottlenecks at all stages of bringing a product from production to market, to enhance overall efficiency and productivity. Climate Change poses significant risks to agri-value chains and underscores the urgent need to integrate climate resilience into value chain interventions to achieve poverty reduction and food security goals. Climate Resilient Agriculture involves implementing sustainable farming practices such as efficient water management, soil conservation, and crop diversification to adapt to climate change. To build value chains that are climate resilient, each actor along the value chain must assess climate risks and manage the activities that make up the value chain adaptivity.

With a view to create awareness among various stakeholders regarding value chain vulnerability and climate resilience, BIRD-Mangaluru has designed a three-day basic training programme on the subject for the benefit of Banks/FIs, NGOs, FPOs, CSR Wings, Trusts, Societies and Government Departments.

Program Objectives:

By the end of the programme, the participants will be able to :-

- ❖ Explain concept of climate science, factors leading to climate change and its impact on agriculture.
- ❖ Explain Climate Change adaptation and mitigation measures.
- ❖ Explain Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- ❖ Explain Environment, Social & Governance (ESG)
- ❖ Explain climate resilient agriculture, including models like hydroponics, aeroponics, etc.
- ❖ Explain definition of Value Chain and role of value chain players
- ❖ Explain differences between supply chain and value chain.
- ❖ Explain mapping of value chain, market linkages and factors enabling success of linkages
- ❖ Explain standards and certifications in agricultural commodities.
- ❖ Explain potential available for value chain and government support.
- ❖ Explain value chain financing.
- ❖ Explain marketing of agricultural produce including issues like quality, pricing, branding, geographical indicators, etc.
- ❖ Explain different market tools including online marketing.
- ❖ Explain mainstreaming gender and livelihood issues with value chain

Training Methodology: Interactive lecture sessions, Computer aided presentations, Group discussions and field visits

Fee & Mode of Payment: The programme is sponsored by NABARD and hence **no participation fee** is collected from banks towards boarding, lodging and to impart training to the participants. However, concerned Bank may bear the to and fro travelling cost of the participants to attend the programme.

Venue and Accommodation: The programme is residential and will be conducted at **Hotel Germanus, Madurai, Tamil Nadu**. The participants are eligible to avail accommodation in the venue on twin sharing basis from the **evening of 20th July 2025 (6.00 pm) till the evening (9.00 PM) of 23rd July 2025**. **Participants will have to make their own travel arrangements. No cost in this regard will be borne by BIRD.** Participants may make their travel plans in such a manner as to reach the venue well in advance and report before the commencement of the programme on the first day and also **leave only after completion of the programme (5.00 PM) on the concluding day.**

It may please be noted that family member/s or guest/s of the participants will not be allowed to stay in the Venue. The nominating institutions are strictly advised not to send any such participants. Prior permission may be obtained by the participants for overstay, in case of any unforeseen circumstances or emergencies only and in such cases, additional cost, if any, may be borne by the respective participant.

A. By Road

Madurai District is well connected with the National Highways NH 7, NH 45B, NH 208 and NH 49 passing through Madurai. The state highways passing through the city are SH-33, SH-72, SH-72A, SH-73 and SH-73A which connect various parts of Madurai district.

B. By Rail

Madurai Junction is the major railway station serving the District. Being the headquarters of the Madurai division of the Southern Railway, there are direct trains connecting Madurai with other major cities and towns across India including New Delhi, Mumbai, Calcutta and Chennai.

C. By Air

Madurai Airport was established in 1957 and is located at Avaniyapuram, about 12 kilometres (7.5 mi) from the city. It offers domestic flights to some cities in India. The airport was declared a customs airport in 2012 allowing limited number of international flights and international services to Colombo, Dubai and Singapore. The carriers operating from the airport are Air India, Air India Express, Jet Airways, SpiceJet, Indigo and Srilankan Airlines.
